The TREASURER'S REPORT

- **Tom McGrath** reported the Chapter Operational Fund is \$1,260.61 and the Ohio Green Beret Support Group account is \$56,837.28; an additional \$75,000 is invested in the Ohio Green Beret Support Group Scholarship Endowment and supervised by The Columbus Foundation's investment management.

Action: Lastly, Tom changed our two bank accounts to his PO Box (see Membership Registration near the back of these minutes) instead of the unit's address because chapter-related mailings there are often lost. **Patrick Enlow** will change the addresses to our online payment accounts to the same PO Box.



MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

-Meeting agenda was outlined by Mark Arnold and Patrick Enlow. Discussion items follow:

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Patrick Enlow** reiterated the growing threat in cyber security. Chapter officers will soon share documents that include personal or otherwise sensitive information (members' email addresses) via Google Drive. This requires a Gmail internet account.

Patrick's advice to all chapter members:

- Beware of suspect links within email messages and text messages. Think twice about clicking on a link in an email unless it is from a known friend or company you are in correspondence with; never click on a link in a text message.
- Update your computers' operating systems whenever prompted to.
- Never reply to an email with suspect language such as, "Your card was charged \$1000, click here to stop it". Mark these messages as Spam.
- Never enter a username and password into anything that you did not go to on your own.
- Use a password manager such as *Lastpass.com*.
- Do not reuse passwords for multiple sites.
- Run your anti-virus, anti-malware software weekly; however, most operating systems do this automatically and notify you when they do and what its results are.

Lunch cost at AMVETS 89 is paid by the chapter, and the Post committed to preparing and serving this for us monthly.

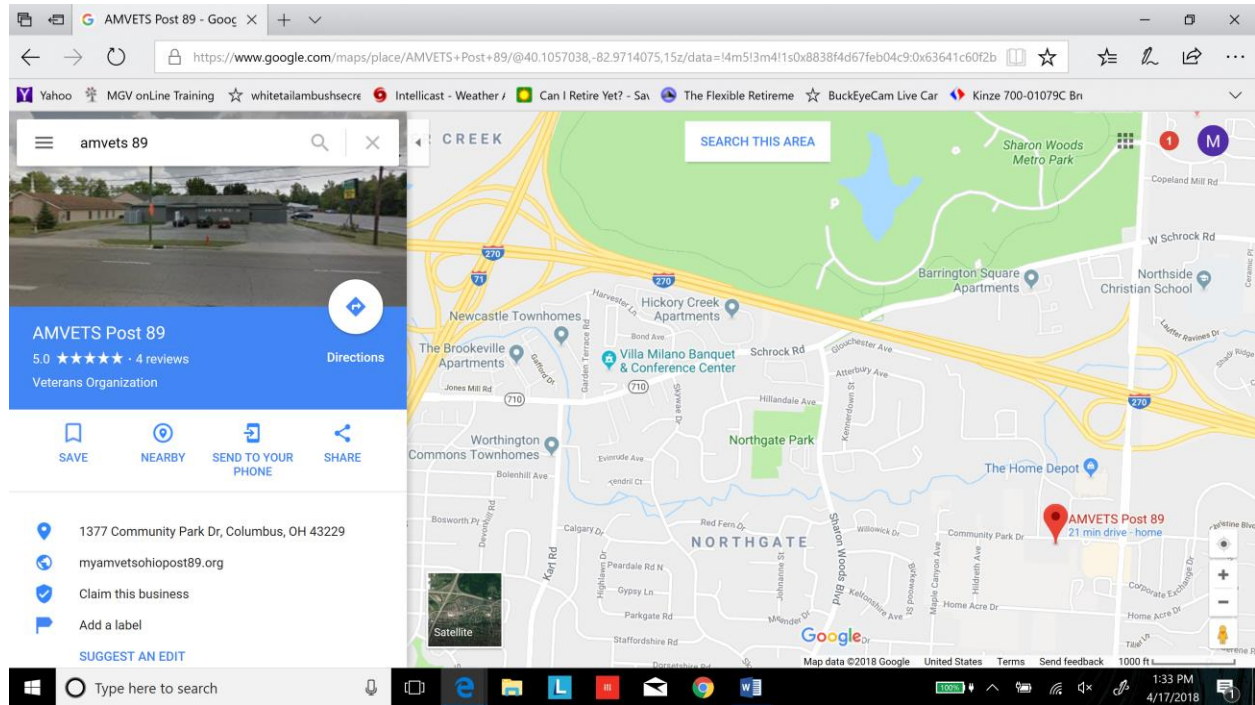

We have three annual \$1000 grants of tuition assistance for chapter members and their immediate family.

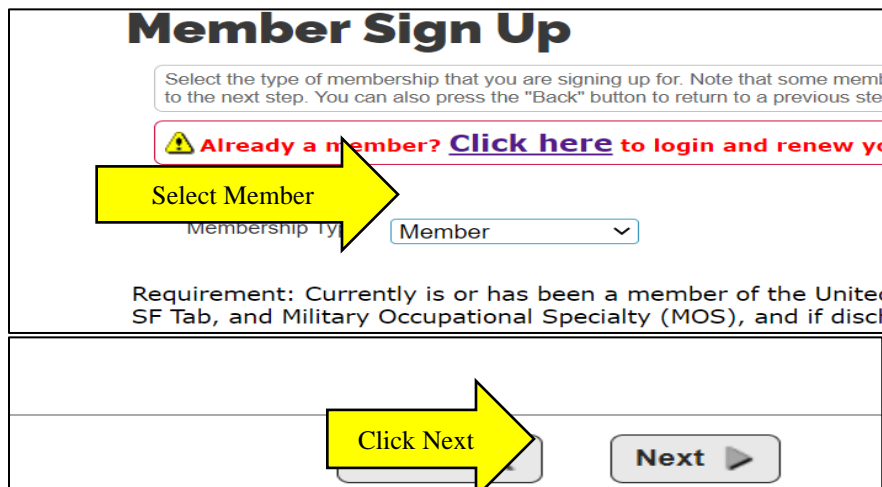
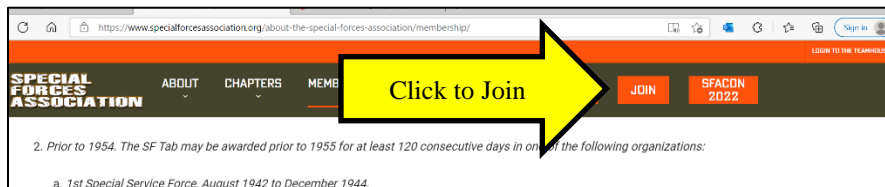

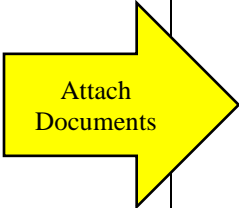

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. This is our primary program for our fund raising which includes two-to-four annual \$1,000 grants of tuition assistance for chapter members and their immediate family.

SF Gold Star Family: The family of SFC Dan Crabtree, KIA Iraq 2005 is our family for the SFA Convention in 2019. SFC Crabtree, 31, was a Special Forces weapons sergeant assigned to the Ohio Army National Guard's Company B, 2nd Battalion, 19th Special Forces Group (Airborne) in Columbus, Ohio. He died June 8, 2006, in Iraq after a roadside bomb exploded next to his vehicle during a combat patrol. In civilian life, Crabtree worked as a police officer first in his native hometown of Hartsville, and then as a member of the Cuyahoga Falls Police Department Special Weapons and Tactics, or SWAT, unit.

Support to families of wounded Green Berets: We pay for all expenses of the unit's annual Christmas party including gifts for the children of Green Berets. We also provide support for the expenses of the unit's family days and awards parties and we support nominations of qualified Green Berets into the Ohio Military Hall of Fame for Valor and make donations to that organization.
