MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

-Meeting agenda was outlined by **Patrick Enlow**. Discussion items follow:

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. **MSG Philip Taraska** provided a link to B/2/19 SFG's new website. It provides a thorough overview of the process of joining the unit as a tabbed SF Soldier and for joining as a SF candidate. The new website includes standards and how to prepare for selection. It also has a thorough overview of Special Forces and all the courses members can attend during the qualification process and during their career in SF. - 2. **Jim Butler** asked the chapter to consider recognizing Fran Wesseling, Director, The Green Beret Foundation, as an Honorary Green Beret. Jim said the cost is minimal and he would cover it himself. This brief discussion was quickly approved during the meetings, and Jim will follow up with coordinating instructions with SFA National.
- 3. **Ed Wheeler** showed a YouTube video "Searching for Paul" during the meeting in Cincinnati. It describes the search at the crash site where his father's aircraft was shot down in Italy during WWII. The effort included US military and the local Italian government.
- 4. The Cincinnati-based group voted to have September's meeting on **Labor Day**, 5 September at the Hofbrauhaus, Newport, KY.
- 5. **Mark Arnold** provided a brief overview of an initiative with which he is involved. It is an Ambassador Fellowship Campaign called *Ohio Stands With Ukraine*. Mark asked the chapter membership if it would support Chapter 45 being named as an organization that supports this Information Operations initiative. After discussion, we decided to communicate this to the chapter and ask for any dissenting comments via email. The chapter will notify the Fellowship Campaign of its support, or not, after email comments from members are compiled during 15-30 August. Philip Taraska is leading this initiative. He and **Dave Spriggs** reported the design was 3-D scanned at OSU and a wax mold will be fabricated from this at Bent Tree Studios in Westerville, OH That mold will be sent to Casting Arts Technology in Cincinnati for fabrication of the bronze statue. Final costs are still being negotiated but estimates for the entire project range: \$33,000 to \$38,000.

9. MONTHLY LUNCHEONS AND MEETINGS: first Monday and second Thursday of each month at 1145 hrs.


