MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

-Meeting agenda was outlined by **Patrick Enlow.** Discussion items follow:

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Ohio Green Beret Support Group Scholarship Program.

The Columbus Foundation reported that no applications were sent for the October scholarship award. Only one scholarship of \$1000 was awarded in May.

Mark Arnold reported that the scholarship program's principle that began at \$75,000 at the Columbus Foundation has increased to over \$91,000 as of 12 December due to appreciation in value of the Vanguard fund it is invested in.

Mark suggested the chapter discuss donating another \$10,000 to \$15,000 from the Ohio Green Beret Support Group's funds to increase the principle of the scholarship fund to over \$100,000. This will enable two scholarships of \$2000 each.

Mark also suggested that the chapter begin discussions about expanding the eligibility to grandchildren of chapter members.

Open Action Items:

- 1. Tom McGrath reported that the Small Claims Court case for the over-charge of the construction and installation of the Crabtree Memorial has been moved to the General Division of the Franklin County Municipal Court. Tom filed on behalf of the Chapter a third party complaint against the plaintiff, Tizzano. All court filings have been changed to electronic records and this was lost in the transition but is being processed now. There is a pre-trial hearing on 28 February 2024. Tom will ask for a summary judgment and attempt to avoid this case being directed to mediation by the judge. Tom's arguments include: 1) the plaintiff cashed the check we provided him and then asked for more money beyond the agreed sum two weeks later, and 2) the plaintiff is asking for money on behalf of a third party, which is inappropriate. Tom is confident that the plaintiff will have to hire an attorney to continue the lawsuit, and this will cost more than the \$4738 he is asking for.
- 2. **Patrick Enlow** and **Eric Stansifer** will link the chapter's Stripe account to payment online for future 3-Gun Shoot registrations via Practiscore.com and they will get three credit card readers for mobile transactions including donations with iOs and Android compatibility.

It is at a convenient location: I-270 North and Cleveland Ave. exit. It is less than a quarter mile south of this exit.


