The TREASURER'S REPORT

**Chadd Kuhn** reported the SFA 45 operational account has \$4612.44 and \$1374.11 remains at 5<sup>th</sup> Third Bank.

The Ohio Green Beret Support Group has \$45,151.00, plus another \$1000 donation will soon be deposited, plus the \$1374.11 from the 5<sup>th</sup> Third Bank.

All funds and accounts will be at the Chase Bank before the end of January.

**Tom McGrath** will file a form 990-N electronically before 15 May. This is an annual

requirement for our charitable organization, the Ohio Green Beret Support Group. Tom will train Chadd Kuhn how to make this annual filing.

**MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)**

-Meeting agenda was outlined by **Patrick Enlow**. Discussion items follow:

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**1. Ohio Green Beret Support Group Scholarship Program.**

**Mark Arnold** stated that the principle was up to over \$101,000 but fluctuates with the rise and fall of the value of the mutual fund it is invested in and managed by The Columbus Foundation. This sum is based on an initial \$75,000 placed into the account; investment performance has resulted in the account growing considerably despite multiple \$1000 scholarships since its inception in January 2020.

Mark suggested that the chapter consider adding more money from the Ohio Green Beret Support Group into the Scholarship Program's corpus to enable a total of \$4000 to \$5000 in scholarships annually. The Foundation's rules limit scholarship expenses to 4% annually of the endowed corpus.

Chapter members at the Columbus meeting discussed this and concluded unanimously to expand the scholarship program by up to \$5000 annually and open its eligible recipients to grandchildren of chapter members.

Mark will take this discussion to the Cincinnati meeting during February and gain members' thoughts and desires there.

Lunch cost at AMVETS 89 is paid by the chapter, and the Post committed to preparing and serving this for us monthly.

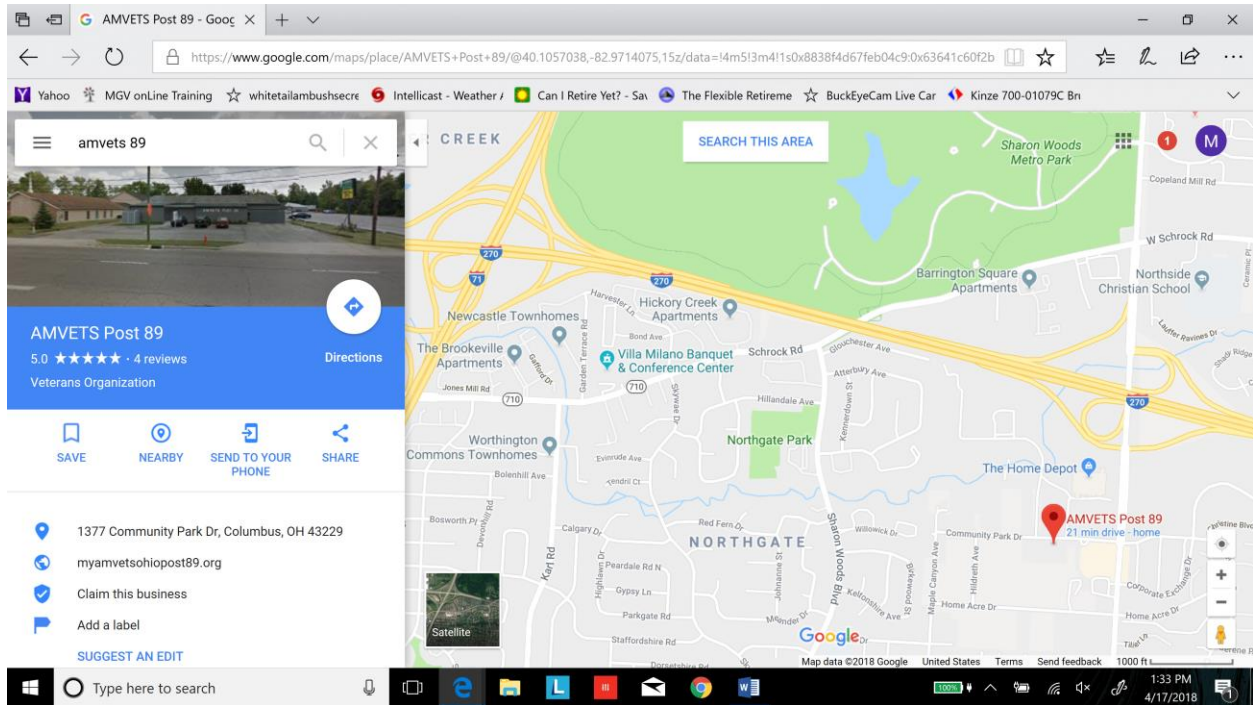

Next application window is now open through **1 October 2023**.

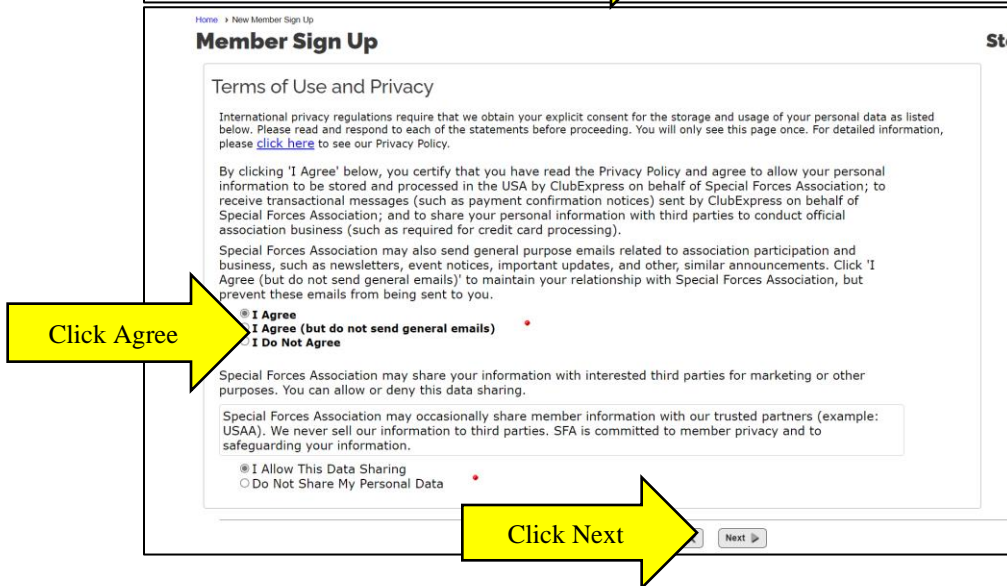
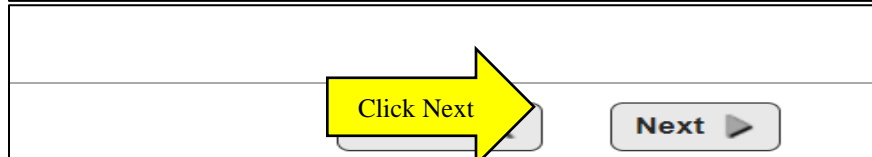
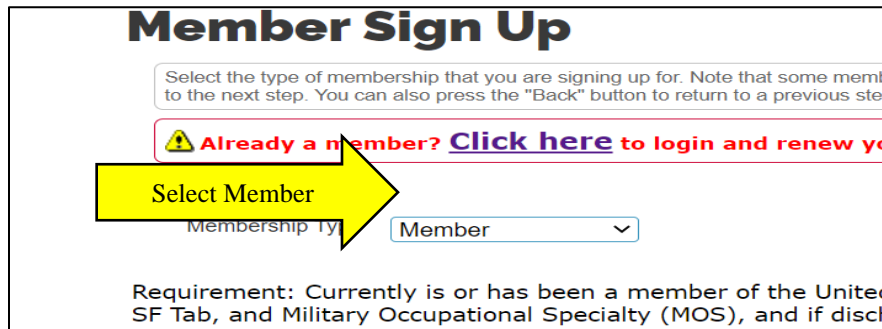
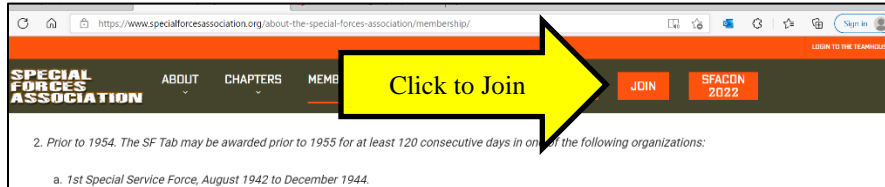

**SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.** This is our primary program for our fund raising which includes two-to-four annual \$1,000 grants of tuition assistance for chapter members and their immediate family.

**SF Gold Star Family:** The family of SFC Dan Crabtree, KIA Iraq 2005 is our family for the SFA Convention in 2019. SFC Crabtree, 31, was a Special Forces weapons sergeant assigned to the Ohio Army National Guard's Company B, 2nd Battalion, 19th Special Forces Group (Airborne) in Columbus, Ohio. He died June 8, 2006, in Iraq after a roadside bomb exploded next to his vehicle during a combat patrol. In civilian life, Crabtree worked as a police officer first in his native hometown of Hartsville, and then as a member of the Cuyahoga Falls Police Department Special Weapons and Tactics, or SWAT, unit.

**Support to families of wounded Green Berets:** We pay for all expenses of the unit's annual Christmas party including gifts for the children of Green Berets. We also provide support for the expenses of the unit's family days and awards parties and we support nominations of qualified Green Berets into the Ohio Military Hall of Fame for Valor and make donations to that organization.
