### The TREASURER'S REPORT

• **Tom McGrath** reported the Chapter Operational Fund is \$1,260.61 and the Ohio Green Beret Support Group account is \$56,837.28; an additional \$75,000 is invested in the Ohio Green Beret Support Group Scholarship Endowment and supervised by The Columbus Foundation's investment management.

### MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

-Meeting agenda was outlined by Mark Arnold and Patrick Enlow. Discussion items follow:

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. **Patrick Enlow** reiterated the growing threat in <u>cyber security</u>. Chapter officers will soon share documents that include personal or otherwise sensitive information (members' email addresses) via Google Drive. This requires a Gmail internet account.
- Patrick's advice to all chapter members:
  - Beware of suspect links within email messages and text messages. Think twice about clicking on a link in an email unless it is from a known friend or company you are in correspondence with; never click on a link in a text message.
  - Update your computers' operating systems whenever prompted to.
  - Never reply to an email with suspect language such as, "Your card was charged \$1000, click here to stop it". Mark these messages as Spam.
  - Never enter a username and password into anything that you did not go to on your own.
  - Use a password manager such as *Lastpass.com*.
  - Do not reuse passwords for multiple sites.
  - Run your anti-virus, anti-malware software weekly; however, most operating systems do this automatically and notify you when they do and what its results are.
- 2. **Scholarship Recipients.** The Columbus Foundation selected and notified three recipients of the Ohio Green Beret Support Group's scholarships. Recipients are children of SFA 45 chapter members. The following are the three students selected by the Columbus Foundation:

<u>Day Two</u>: (Sunday) GoRuck will execute an <u>active shooter intervention class</u> at Richwood Gun and Game Club.

Club President, Steve Ormeroid supports the concept. Its purpose is to provide a venue for and events that attract a larger community of shooters, the public, law enforcement, and the military to interact with each other and also draw more support to our fundraising efforts and recruitment of members to the Gun and Game Club. It is at a convenient location: I-270 North and Cleveland Ave. exit. It is less than a quarter mile south of this exit.



Next application window is now open through May 2023.


