MEETING DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS (leads for actions noted in bold)

- -Meeting agenda was outlined by Mark Arnold. Discussion items follow:
 - GREEN BERET FOUNDATION GOLF TOURNAMENT. The GBF has scheduled its second annual Cincinnati Green Beret Classic (Golf Tournament) for 12 September in Loveland, OH just north east of Cincinnati. A dinner is planned in Loveland for 11 SEP. Details will be shared soon. The hosts are seeking volunteers to assist with the Classic's set up and execution. Larry Verne is the POC: 513-891-0078.
 - CHAPTER DINNER EVENT. We will plan an evening dinner, pizza night or some
 informal dining get together for the chapter during May or June. We have many
 members and prospective members whose schedules prevent them from participating in
 lunch time meetings. Tom McGrath will draft a plan for the Cincinnati area and central
 Ohio.
 - 3. CHAPTER WEBSITE. **Patrick Enlow**, Acting Chapter Secretary is completing this website's third version. Within the new site, he will use *MailChimp* as a means of communicating to chapter members and for recruiting. It will include tabs to easily update your membership dues by clicking tabs in the website, transfer to the chapter, apply for membership, and make donations.
 - 4. CHAPTER FACE BOOK PAGE. **SFA 45** is our Facebook page. Patrick Enlow will begin to make this a Private page by inviting SFA 45 members to join.
