The TREASURER'S REPORT

• Tom McGrath reported the Chapter Operational Fund is \$3029.87 and the Ohio Green Beret Support Group account is \$52,018.28; an additional \$75,000 is invested in the Ohio Green Beret Support Group Scholarship Endowment and supervised by The Columbus Foundation's investment management; Tom will ask the Foundation the current value of the endowment and will report it during December's meeting.

-Meeting agenda was outlined by Mark Arnold and Patrick Enlow. Discussion items follow:

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Chapter By-Laws.

Tom McGrath is seeking written guidance from SFA National regarding the approval to vote via email since gaining a quorum among our 180 + chapter members during monthly meetings is impossible. He will also propose a resolution to the chapter by-laws regarding spending thresholds for membership votes.

2. B/2/19 SFG Christmas Gifts.

Philip Taraska asked the chapter to buy \$50 gift certificates for each of the children of the members of B/2/19 SFG. We did this last year at a cost of \$5500 because the pandemic resulted in the unit's Christmas party being cancelled. This year's party is cancelled too because the unit remains deployed. The chapter members voted to support the children of the unit members again. **MSG Philip Taraska** has the lead on this; we ask that the certificates be enclosed in SF Christmas cards.

- 3. Next SFA National Convention is 20-24 SEP 2022 at Colorado Springs. 2023's convention will be in Indianapolis.
- 4. **Patrick Enlow** suggested to **Tom McGrath** the chapter create a new bank account that SFA National can access for direct deposit monthly of the chapter's income from membership dues.
- 5. SFA 45 will honor **Fran Wessling**, Board member of the Green Beret Foundation during our 6 December meeting in Cincinnati.

It is at a convenient location: I-270 North and Cleveland Ave. exit. It is less than a quarter mile south of this exit.


